



SHEPHERD

Free pattern Easy Crochet Scarf

STITCHES USED - Chain
- Double Crochet
- Treble

MEASUREMENTS -

Width (approx)	cm	7
Length (approx, excluding fringe)	cm	130

YARN REQUIRED -

SHEPHERD LAMBSWOOL

12 ply	
50g balls	2

HOOK AND EXTRAS -

- 7.00mm Crochet Hook.
- A Wool Needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION -

The tension is not critical for a successful scarf.

ABBREVIATIONS -

mm = millimetres

cm = centimetres

SCARF

Using 7.00mm Hook, make 147 chain.

1st row - Miss 3 chain, 1 treble in each chain to end ... 145 treble (3 chain at beginning counts as 1 treble).

2nd row - 1 double crochet and 1 chain in first treble, * 1 chain, miss 1 treble, 1 treble in next treble, repeat from * to last treble and turning chain, 1 chain, 1 treble in top of turning chain.

3rd row - 1 double crochet and 1 chain in first treble, 1 treble in next chain, * 1 chain, miss 1 treble, 1 treble in next chain, repeat from * to turning chain, 1 treble in top of turning chain.

4th row - 1 double crochet and 1 chain in first treble, * 1 chain, miss 1 treble, 1 treble in next chain, repeat from * to last treble and turning chain, 1 chain, 1 treble in top of turning chain.

5th row - 1 double crochet and 1 chain in first treble, 1 treble in each chain and treble to turning chain, 1 treble in top of turning chain.
Fasten off.

MAKE UP

Using wool needle, sew in ends. Using 8 strands each 30cm long for each fringe, attach 5 fringes evenly along each end of scarf as pictured.
